## ACCESS INFORMATION:

Closest accessible public transport is ferry or train stopping at Circular Quay (an accessible station). Pathway from Circular Quay to Opera House is continuous. Some accessible buses stop at Circular Quay. Contact 131 500 for information about times and lines or visit www.sydneybuses.nsw.gov.au or www.cityrail.info

Drop off and pick up point on Sydney Opera House Concourse (look for Club Wild signs), approx 100 metres from The Studio. Marshalls in Club Wild t-shirts will direct you. Limited accessible parking spaces under the Sydney Opera House Concourse – enquire about booking these with Box Office when purchasing your tickets. General parking in Sydney Opera House Enacon car park off Macquarie St (vehicles under 2.2m only). Parking for Club Wild patrons \$16 on presentation of ticket to the event.

Wheelchair access to The Studio via Stage Door entry, located under the stairs. Patrons will be guided to a suitable lift. Rest seating available in The Studio. Some smoke effects and limited pyrotechnics used during Club Wild.

Food and drink available at the venue or at Circular Quay. No alcohol sold in The Studio but licensed bars available in foyer. All ages welcome.
